Of All Things...

CATECHISM 101

We are continuing with an old series about our Catholic faith, called 'Catechism 101' mostly a summary from the Catechism of the Catholic Church. The purpose of the series is to refresh our knowledge on our set of beliefs.

This week, the key question is about the Holy Spirit. **'I believe in the Holy Spirit'**

WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Trinity who proceeds from the Father and the Son. The Holy Spirit is the one to awaken faith in us and to communicate to us the new life, which is to know the Father and the one whom he has sent, Jesus-Christ. "No one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit" (1 Cor 12:3). "God has sent the Spirit into our hearts, crying 'Abba! Father'" (Gal 4:6). The knowledge of faith is possible only in the Holy Spirit.

WHERE DO WE FIND THE HOLY SPIRIT?

1. In the Scriptures he inspired.
2. In the tradition, to which the Church Fathers are always timely witnesses.
3. In the Church's Magisterium, which he assists.
4. In the sacramental liturgy, in which he put us in communion with Christ.
5. In prayer wherein he intercedes for us.
6. In the charisms and ministries by which the church is built up.

7. In the signs of apostolic and missionary life.
8. In the witness of saints through whom he manifests his holiness and continues the work of salvation.

WHAT IS THE NAME OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, AND TITLES?

1. Spirit is the proper name, Hebrew word is ruah meaning breath, air, or wind.
2. Jesus calls him the 'Paraclete' meaning consoler.
3. Jesus also calls him: 'the Spirit of truth'.
4. St Paul gives him the titles like 'the Spirit of the promise', the 'spirit of adoption', the 'spirit of Christ', the 'Spirit of the Lord', the 'Spirit of God'.
5. St Peter calls him 'the Spirit of glory'.

WHAT ARE THE SYMBOLS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT?

1. Water, water of baptism.
2. Anointing, the oil symbolizes the Spirit.
3. Fire, birth and fruitfulness of life.
4. Cloud and light, on mount Sinai they veil the transcendence of God's glory.
5. The seal, indelible character.
6. The hand, imposition of the hand.
7. The finger, the finger of God.
8. The dove, at the of the flood the spirit of God was revealed.

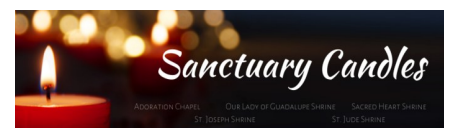

Itinerary

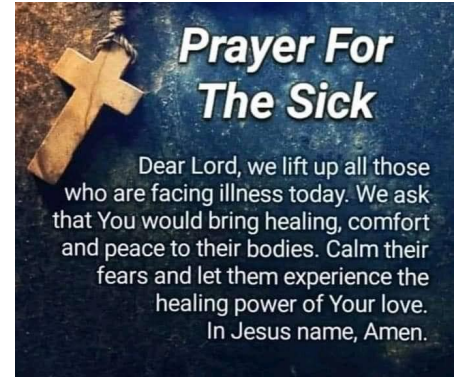
- Tuesday, June 2 at 5:00 p.m.**

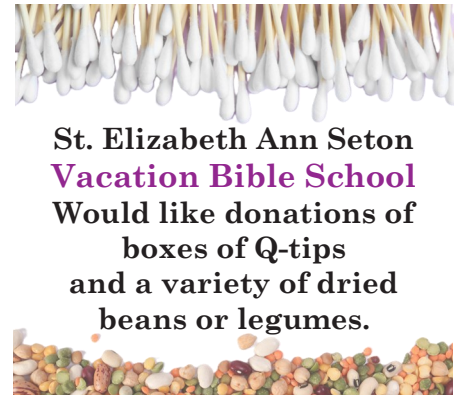

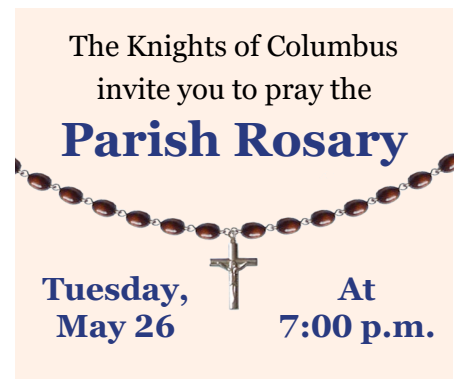

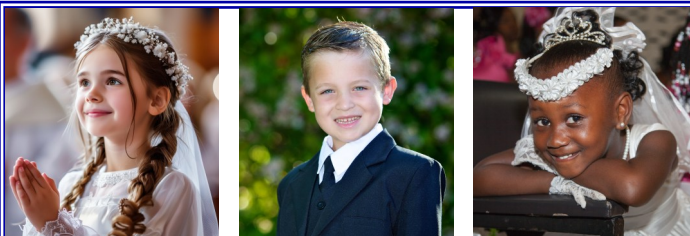
