Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

On August 8/9, our parishes will take up a collection to aid the Church in Latin America and the Solidarity Fund for the Church in Africa, splitting the funds between these two vital initiatives.

Sacrament of Baptism:

Congratulations on the birth of your child and your decision to baptize. Parents must be registered members of our parish. Baptism is generally celebrated on the second Sunday of the month after the 12:00 noon mass (subject to change.) Completion of baptism class (if required) and ALL required documents must be received in the parish office **prior** to scheduling the baptism date. Godparents need to present a letter of "Good Standing" from the parish they attend.
